Final call for support – Moree and Glen Innes Hospital petitions



Petitions are available to be signed at most Moree businesses and my office in Balo Street, Moree. Glen Innes petitions can be signed at the council chambers in Church Street.

IF you haven't already, I am urging anyone in the Moree Plains District and the Glen Innes Severn area to take time to sign the petitions that will help secure funding for hospital upgrades in these areas. Specifically, \$80 million to rebuild the Moree Hospital and \$20 million to refurbish the Glen Innes Hospital will deliver top-class medical facilities and replace ageing infrastructure.

This is important campaign and to date, the support has been impressive with more than 8,000 signatures secured – but we need more. The Mayors of both communities – Mayor Katrina Humphries at Moree Plains Shire and Mayor Carol Sparks at Glen Innes Severn, have been tireless supporters in rallying local support.

The positive impact and difference a well-supported campaign can have when I meet with the Health Minister to secure that financial commitment, cannot be overstated.

So, thank you in advance for your support and I will keep the community updated on our progress. Petitions can be found in my Moree office, at the Glen Innes Severn Council or call either office for a copy to be sent to you.

Campaign continues for Armidale Business Park

OVER the next few weeks I will working hard to secure \$6.5 million from the State Government to develop the proposed Armidale Regional Airport 73-lot Business Park.

Economic development and job creation is a huge priority. With around 200 new jobs set to be created with the development of the park, this would be the biggest jobs creation project Armidale has seen for decades.

The construction of the \$3 million roundabout on the New England Highway will soon be completed and will provide access to the park, the airport and Saumarez Homestead.

Council will also contribute \$2.2 million to subdivide 17.5 hectares of land to the immediate south of the airport, building roads, utilities and amenities to cater to up to dozens of new industrial and commercial lots.

This area is perfect for industrial and commercial usage, providing direct access to the airport precinct and the New

England Highway. It's an area for business development that Armidale has traditionally lacked.

These plans have been a long time in the making, but now the time is right to open up this park and start creating hundreds of new jobs in the region.

\$779.5 million secured for

As your local MP, I've worked hard over the past four years to ensure the Northern Tablelands has received its fair share of the NSW Government's record spend on infrastructure, health, education and roads.

Since March 2015, **\$779.5 million** has been secured for hundreds of projects in every corner of the electorate. Here's a snapshot of just some of those projects that together we have gained.

Building country bridges

- **\$7.8 million** to upgrade Nee Nee Creek Bridge, north of Moree.
- **\$250,000** for a two-lane bridge over Cam Creek, Dundee.
- **\$510,000** for the new Tenterden Bridge between Guyra and Tingha.
- **\$800,000** for the construction of Tin Tot Bridge at Graman.
- **\$705,000** for the Abington Creek Bridge between Uralla and Armidale.
- **\$1.7 million** for the Gwydir Shire to upgrade Bingara's Gwydir River and Halls Creek bridge.

Water security

- **\$12.38 million** for the Malpas Dam to Guyra water pipeline and treatment works.
- **\$3.7 million** for a new sewage system at Bundarra.
- **\$4.6 million** to drought-proof Boggabilla & Toomelah with a bi-directional water pipeline.
- **\$3.96 million** for a water pipeline from Pallamallawa to Biniguy.
- **\$4.13 million** to construct water supply for Ashley.
- **\$3.12 million** to improve water pressure and supply in Moree.
- **\$1.6 million** to upgrade Copeton Dam's water supply system.
- **\$970,000** to upgrade off-stream water storage at Glen Innes.

Stronger Country Communities

- **\$126,390** for a range of community improvement projects in Boomi.
- **\$110,000** to upgrade toilets and amenities at Mungindi Showgrounds.
- **\$138,000** for upgrades to Deepwater Tennis Club.
- **\$114,000** to install shade sails and benches at the Tingha Community Skatepark.
- **\$115,000** to upgrade Warialda's showground kitchen and dining room.
- **\$1,881,606** to make improvements at Lake Inverell.
- **\$300,000** to build a library at Bingara.
- **\$512,443** to upgrade infrastructure at Wilson Park, Glen Innes.
- **\$1,093,196** to build a new hydrotherapy pool at Armidale.
- **\$4.2 million** for netball and sporting complex in Glen Innes.



Fixing country roads

- **\$3.03 million** for a Warialda by-pass.
- **\$10 million** for upgrade to New England Highway between Uralla and Armidale.
- **\$2 million** to widen and seal the last gravel section of Bingara road.
- **\$14 million** to seal Carrigan road between Mungindi and Boomi.
- **\$3.5 million** for upgrade of Carnarvon Highway between Carole Creek Bridge and Marshall Pond Bridge.
- **\$122 million** Newell Highway upgrade project, south of Boggabilla.


Investing in health care

- **\$60 million** for the redevelopment of Armidale Hospital.
- **\$60 million** for the redevelopment of the Inverell Hospital.
- **\$260,000** for major extensions at the Guyra Medical Centre.
- **\$1.8 million** to upgrade facilities at the Glen Innes Hospital.
- **\$2 million** on new Moree Renal Unit.
- **\$1.7 million** on refurbishment of Moree Hospital operating theatres.

Infrastructure projects

- **\$9 million** for a new 24-hour Inverell Police Station.
- **\$6 million** on TAFE NSW Digital headquarters in Armidale.
- NSW Service Centres in Inverell, Glen Innes and Armidale.
- **\$8.5 million** on Armidale Regional Airport upgrade.

Education

- **\$117 million** for Armidale Secondary College.
- **\$15.68 million** for school maintenance funding across the region.
- **\$1.2 million** for upgrade works at Glen Innes High School.
- **\$15 million** for a new Moree East Public School.
- **\$47 million** in Gonski funding for 59 public schools in the Northern Tablelands.

Cultural investments

- **\$846,000** for the Armidale Cultural Centre and Keeping Place.
- **\$95,050** for the Land of the Beardies Museum in Glen Innes.
- **\$240,000** for New England Regional Art Museum in Armidale.
- **\$300,000** to construct a new library in Bingara's Civic Centre.
- **\$2 million** for Bingara tourism project.
- **\$95,000** for Arts North West to create and promote Aboriginal art in the region.
- **\$16,196** for Uralla Shire Council for an Aboriginal cultural display.

What next for the Northern Tablelands ?

Over the next few months I will be working to lock in funds in the government's June budget for some important projects for our region.

- **\$80m** to fully redevelop the Moree Hospital.
- **\$20 million** to refurbish the Glen Innes Hospital.
- **\$6.5 million** for the Armidale Business Park.
